STARTING PROCEDURE, COURSES, and COURSE NOTES

Starting Procedure Races will be started by using rule 26 with the following addition:
 An attention signal (flag F) will be displayed on the race committee signal boat when the committee is on station. Flag F will be removed with multiple sounds one minute before the first warning signal. This changes rule 27.1.

Course Change: No later than the **preparatory signal**, the race committee signal boat will display the course designation for the **fleet** in sequence. This changes RRS 27.1. If the race committee changes the course designation from what is being sailed by the previous fleet, it may indicate a course change by displaying a lime green flag. The lime green flag will be lowered one minute before the start. These are not timed signals. This changes RRS 33.

Individual Recall: Will be in accordance with RRS 29.1. The Race Committee *may* call sail numbers of the boats recorded OCS on VHF channel 65A. This changes RRS 41. Failure to receive the transmission will not relieve a boat of the responsibility of starting properly, and is not grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

General Recall: Will be in accordance with RRS 29.2 except the last sentence is deleted and replaced by: "The Starting Order and timing of subsequent starts will proceed as if there had been no General Recall. The recalled fleet will be restarted after the last fleet in the scheduled starting order. If more than one fleet has been recalled, they will restart in the order they were recalled."

Government Marks

Can "ISC", Fl R "4", Fl Y "A" and Fl "HP" are to be passed on the channel side.

Special Drop Marks

All special drop marks are orange cylinders except mark "A", "C" and R2. **Mark "A" is a red cone.** Mark C is Green can "1" Hacketts Point. Mark R2 is red flashing 2.5 sec. bell. Marks not used may not be in place. Approximate GPS coordinates of special marks are listed below.

Courses

The course designations are black letters or numbers on white boards except the "R" is a representation of code flag "R" (red field with yellow cross).

The first mark of the course is Mark "A" and is passed to port. Mark "A" is not a mark on any future leg of the course.
