STARTING PROCEDURE, COURSES, and COURSE NOTES

Starting Procedure

Races will be started under RRS 26 (Starting Races). Code flag “F” (red diamond on white background) will be displayed at the starting area when the Race Committee is on station. This flag will be lowered with several short sound signals one minute before the first class’s Warning signal.

Government Marks

Can “1SC”, Fl R “4”, Fl Y “A” and Fl “HP” are marks of the course and are to be passed on the channel side. Marks “A”, “B”, “C”, “D” refer to yellow cans in vicinity of the Naval Academy (Yellow Can “A” is NOT Dolphin Fl Y “A”).

Special Drop Marks

S is a drop mark approximately 200 yards South of the Naval Academy Bridge at @ 38 59.534 N and 76 29.165 W.

S1 is a drop mark bearing approximately 223 deg, from red Annapolis Harbor Channel Light 4 at @ 38 57.961 N and 76 27.576 W.

Courses

Any course designation followed by the letter “R” shall be followed in reverse order.

For Hartford Light starts, numeral “1” preceding the course board(s) changes the starting pin to “Can 1SC”.

For Triton Light starts, numeral “1” preceding the course board(s) changes the starting pin to yellow “Can B”
